NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH GROUP ALERT

SEPTEMBER 6, 2020

We have been having some disturbing things happening in Timberlake recently. We would appreciate your vigilance in watching out for your neighbors. If you see suspicious vehicles/persons, please try to get as much information as you can, ie: description/color of vehicle/license plate number. Please provide this information to either Mary Jo Wallen at 783-4207 or Nancy Wills at 783-2457. Also, it is very important that you report burglaries and vandalism to either McKinley County (505-722-7205) or Cibola (505-287-9476) Sheriff's Departments so they can determine if there are any patterns for this negative activity.

- 1. A house in the front part of the development (Cibola) was broken into by breaking a large window and jimmied a door.
- 2. Another house was supposedly broken into in the middle and edge of the development next to National Forest (McKinley), but we have not been able to verify with a police report.
- 3. Several reports have been coming in where they think houses are being "cased" in several areas of the development.
- 4. Yesterday evening a landowner left their lime green Ocean kayak hidden in the weeds (Common land) down by the old boat dock area at the lake around 6 p.m. When they went back this morning to use their kayak, it was gone. It was reported that at least 5

ATV's and 2 SUV's were in the area after 6 p.m. and a pickup truck was seen going in and out of the lake area after dark...presumably to steal the kayak. Since only landowners are supposed to have a lake gate key, it is incredibly sad to imagine that a fellow landowner stole property.

- 5. Complaints are received weekly about kids riding ATV's extremely fast down all the roads and no helmets are worn. So far, no serious injuries have been reported, but do you want your child to be the first?
- 6. Another landowner reported that slash has been thrown into their yard (lives right off Timberlake). All landowners are asked to take their slash to the burn pile.
- 7. A dark colored vehicle with rear spoiler has been seen and heard racing Timberlake Road coming in and out of the development. If there is a landowner who owns this type of a vehicle, would you please let us know so we do not report it as a "suspicious vehicle".
